On Eagles' Wings –

Perhaps the most complete Torah picture of all time, this artist numbered and signed lithograph is filled with hidden symbolism. This unique composition, which took eight months to create, is considered by many to be David's masterpiece.

In the brown area to the left of the Israeli flag (on the eagle's wings), smaller forms compose the larger face of Joshua, seen holding and blowing a shofar. This same brown area is also the base of a larger shofar seen swirling out from beneath and around the tablets of the Ten Commandments.

(Look closer, within the large hidden shofar, the Israelites make their long journey through the wilderness.)







The twelve tribes of Israel are situated along the bottom-left side of the picture. Additionally, the depiction of each tribe embodies the characteristics of Jacob's blessing for the twelve brothers.

Representations of Moses, Aaron, and Miriam, as well as the Jewish people, are interspersed throughout the composition, illustrating the story of their journey to the land of Israel.
