

# – Jerusalem, City of Peace –

This composition portrays Jerusalem during the ultimate time of peace. The unity and harmony of life at this time is depicted both inside and outside the walls of the city. Within the city, ritual objects and traditional accompaniments to Judaism may be found woven into the design.

## Can you find all 50 hidden *shaloms* in the picture?

Look carefully. They are in Hebrew (שלום), English (peace) and transliteration (shalom).

Hint: Try looking in the trees, plants, city-walls, and birds.

## Can you find the many items of Judaica hidden within the city?

Torah Scrolls | Tablets of the Ten Commandments | *mezuzah* | *menorah tefillin* | *kiddush* (wine) cup | *Shabbat* candles | *shofar* (ram's horn) | *havdalah* candle and spice box | Hebrew word for life (chai - חי).
